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REACH Deklaration SIEKMANN ECONOSTO

The European Chemicals Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) is a framework used for the registration, evaluation and authorization of chemical substances. It came into force on June 1, 2007 and aims to find out more about the risks of the 30,000 chemical substances currently used in all industries on the European market. Substances that are associated with very high risks should thus gradually disappear from the market or be subject to special authorization. With this goal in mind, REACH mandatorily regulates the exchange of information on chemical sub-stances within the supply chain, regardless of whether these substances are contained in isolation, in a preparation, in an article or in a product.

Information according to Article 33 REACH:

If so-called substances of very high concern (SVHC) of the candidate list are contained in manufactured articles above a level of 0.1% by weight, manufacturers are obliged to inform their customers in this regard.

As a reliable supplier of industrial products in the sense of the above regulation, SIEKMANN ECONOSTO is a downstream user. We operate neither as a manufacturer nor as an importer of chemical sub-stances.

On June 27, 2018, lead was added to the SVHC candidate list due to its classification as toxic for reproduction (Repro 1A, H360DF). However, there is currently no ban on the use of lead. We have not identified any additional risks for the intended use, repair/maintenance or disposal of the products we supply.

In accordance with the new REACH restriction on lead in PVC (entry 63, Annex XVII), we will ensure that our products containing PVC do not contain more than 0.1% lead by weight from November 29, 2024. This regulation applies to new goods and recycled PVC, for which exceptions previously existed. Siekmann Econosto is committed to reviewing all affected materials and switching to lead-free alternatives.

In some of our manufactured products, materials containing lead are used, which may be affected depending on the material combination or customer specification. As lead is firmly bound in these alloys and no exposure is to be expected, no additional information on safe use is required.
